### **Pondering the Birth of Christ**

*"A helpless Newborn Child in a lowly cave restores dignity to every life being born, and brings hope to those overcome by doubt and discouragement. In that Child, meek and defenseless, crying in a cold and bare cave, God has destroyed sin." - Pope John Paul II*

Advent and Christmas are an opportunity to allow Christ to be born into our hearts and to participate in sharing the gift that the Father, out of His never-ending love, has given to us.

God's infinite love is revealed in the small Infant who is not born in the riches of a Roman palace but rather in a poor manger in Bethlehem. Christ enters the world needing others. As Pope Francis reminded us last Christmas - "the One who embraces the universe needs to be held in another's arms. The One who created the sun needs to be warmed. Through His Son's humble birth, God reminds us that we all need the love, protection, and comfort, and it is through our every actions that we inadvertently affect the lives of others in great ways. We may never know the extent to which a charitable act affects a person, how a listening ear comforts someone who needs to vent, or the amount of hope a prayer can enkindle in someone undergoing personal challenges.
