Dragi farani in prijatelji!

Na marčevski Kulturni uri smo imeli dva gosta.

Najprej nam je **Miro Škrlj** posredoval nekaj vtisov z obiska svojega sina, ki živi na Kitajskem; važno je vedno imeti pri sebi pasport, povsod te spremljajo kamere za prepoznavanje obrazov, povsod se plačuje s karticami, vsaj 90% avtomobilov je električnih, narejenih na Kitajskem, pred 30. leti je Kitajska izdelala 1% svetovne prizvodnje aluminija, danes 60%. Mesta so se včasih dušila v neznosnem smogu, danes pa se zopet vidi modro nebo, ogromna polja z vetrnicami, ki proizvajajo elektriko, so na robovih mest, od koder se po podzemnih kabliah elektrika prenaša v mesta. Kjer so čakalne vrste so res dolge, tako da se več ne jezi, če mora pri nas čakati v vrsti.

Potem nam je **dr. Janez Kranjc** spregovoril o *dr. Mirku Cudermanu* duhovniku, dirigentu, zborovodji, muzikologu in cerkvenem glasbeniku, ki je umrl 27. februarja 2025 v 95. letu starosti.

Po končani Teološki fakulteti v Ljubljani je Cuderman študiral na dunajski Akademiji za glasbeno in gledališko umetnost ter na Filozofski fakulteti, kjer je leta 1960 tudi doktoriral. Po vrnitvi v Ljubljano je bil do leta 1970 regens cori ljubljanske stolnice. Takrat ga je Slovenska filharmonija zaposlila kot vodjo arhiva.

Leta 1968 je ustanovil *Consortium musicum*, ki se je kot vrhunski amaterski zbor več kot tri desetletja posvečal izvajanju vokalno-instrumentalne in a cappella glasbe. V osemdesetih letih je sprejel mesto dirigenta Komornega zbora RTV Slovenija. V tem obdobju je postal tudi predavatelj za zborovsko literaturo, izvajalsko prakso in dirigiranje na Akademiji za glasbo v Ljubljani.

Na njegovo pobudo in pod okriljem ministrstva za kulturo je bil leta 1991 ustanovljen Slovenski komorni zbor, danes Zbor Slovenske filharmonije, katerega umetniški direktor in zborovodja je bil vse od njegove ustanovitve do upokojitve leta 2009. Z njim je posnel celotno zbirko *Musica sacra slovenica*, pa tudi največji projekt svojega življenja: zbirko slovenske posvetne zborovske glasbe. Monumantalen spomenik slovenske zborovske glasbene ustvarjalnosti in truda dr. Cudermana predstavlja trideset CD plošč zbirke *Musica sacra slovenica* v trajanju več kot 34 ur čiste glasbe in 56 CD plošč zbirke *Slovenska zborovska glasba* v skupnem trajanju 61 ur in 37 minut.

Kljub svoji predanosti glasbi, je svoje izjemne darove z velikim uspehom pokazal tudi na organizacijskem in izdajateljskem področju. Med drugim je bil vrsto let uspešen upravnik Družine, ki je v njegovem času izdala številne dragocene knjige in revije.

Za svoje delo je prejel več nagrad in odlikovanj: Župančičevo nagrado (1993), častni znak svobode RS (2001), red za zasluge (2007), Gallusovo plaketo, zlato plaketo JSKD (2011) in nazadnje leta 2022 Prešernovo nagrado za življenjsko delo.

BLAGOSLOVLJENO VELIKO NOČ

Questions about Holy Week you've always wondered

Holy Week is one of the most important moments for Catholics. However, not everyone knows the background and depth of this period, such as why we celebrate it or how it is structured. This article collects six fundamental questions for understanding Holy Week. (Opus Dei)

1. What is Holy Week?

Holy Week is a time of preparation and remembrance of the suffering and death of Jesus Christ. It begins with his arrival in Jerusalem and ends with his crucifixion.

2. How do Catholics celebrate Holy Week?

There are four important rituals during Holy Week.

Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem. On this day, Catholics hold processions with blessed olive branches and greenery.

On Holy Thursday, we remember the betrayal of Judas and the Last Supper, where Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist. In the morning, bishops gather with the priests of their dioceses to consecrate the holy chrism and bless the baptismal and sick oil. On the evening of this day, the Mass commemorates Jesus' Last Supper, which also includes the washing of feet.

Good Friday is the saddest day of the year for Catholics. It commemorates the suffering of Jesus, his arrest, conviction, and death. There is no mass on this day. Jesus died.

On Holy Saturday evening, the main Christian ceremony of the year takes place: the Easter Vigil. It is when we remember the resurrection of Jesus.

3. Why are churches decorated in a special way?

On Good Friday and Saturday, churches are decorated differently than they normally are during the year. In many places, black or purple is used. In some places, crosses are covered up a week before the start of Holy Week, and there is no Eucharist or blessed water on Good Friday and Saturday.

4. Since when do Catholics celebrate Holy Week?

Holy Week has been celebrated since the beginning of the Church. There are documents that testify that as early as the 4th century, Christians in Egypt, Palestine, and in what is now Turkey and Armenia celebrated the Passion of Christ. It is likely that these rituals existed even earlier. This custom came to Europe in the 5th century.

5. When is Holy Week celebrated?

Holy Week is the last week of Lent. It begins on Palm Sunday and ends on Holy Saturday. It is celebrated on a different date each year, determined by the Sunday after the first full moon of spring.

6. When did Holy Week actually happen?

According to calculations, Jesus' resurrection is supposed to have occurred on Sunday, April 9, so April 6 would be Holy Thursday.
